



Miami’s Middle School Math HDT Core Class Program

Total students served in 2023-2024: 291 across 5 PLI study schools

OVERVIEW: In-person math tutoring was delivered as a part of students’ regular math class. Two in-person tutors joined students’ typical math class and instructed students using district materials.

AMOUNT OF TUTORING: Students were intended to receive about 75 minutes of tutoring per week. On average, they received about 8 hours over the school year, 47 percent of the intended amount.

COST: Thirty weeks of this program are estimated to cost \$1,320 per student, including all program resources, not limited to vendor fees.

UNIQUE FEATURES:

- Tutors were in the school building all day and tutoring occurred as a part of students’ classroom rotations.
